Objetivando divulgar os procedimentos iniciais para o Admissão de Alunos Juizes que devem ser adotados conforme o "FIFe Rules for Judges & Student Judges".

Conforme item 1.7 todo juiz é Membro FFB – Federação Felina Brasileira, assim como os Conselheiros de Raça e os Clubes;

1.7 Judges Adherence to a National FIFe Member

Judges must be an individual member of a National FIFe Member.

The FIFe Member, in which a Judge is a member, is not empowered to suspend a Judge from officiating as a Judge either on a temporary or a permanent basis.

2.1.2 Responsibility of the FIFe Member for its Student Judges

The FIFe Member to which the candidate belongs is entirely responsible for the progress and the conduct of the candidate. It can oppose a final examination if in its opinion the candidate does not show sufficient knowledge and is empowered to apply disciplinary measures or suspend a Student Judge on either a temporary or permanent bases.

The FIFe Member shall inform the FIFe Secretariat of the termination of membership of its Student Judges.

Um dos principais requisitos para ser aceito como Aluno Juiz é ser membro ativo por 5 anos

2.1.4.1 Being active member

Before taking the preliminary examination, the candidate must have been an active member of a FIFe Member for at least five years.

Fundamental é o período e as condições de steward que o Aluno Juiz deve ter realizado

2.1.4.2 Amount and period of stewarding

To apply to become a Student Judge, the following procedures must be complied with:

- participation as a steward at 10 national or international shows where the owners are not permitted to present the cats themselves, or
- at 20 national or international shows where the owners may present their own cats
- at least 6 steward certificates must be obtained in at least 2 countries different from the steward's country of residence.
- the participation as a steward must be spread over no less than two years (minimum period).

Through a positive steward certificate, the steward will prove his ability to handle different cats under circumstances which are typical for cat shows.

The steward must have experience in handling cats from all categories to develop an understanding for different breeds and feline behaviour in general.

A prerequisite for an approved steward certificate is that the steward has presented cats in the Best in Show panel for that show. The categories in which the steward has presented cats are indicated on the steward certificate.

2.1.4.3 Experience as a breeder, as an exhibitor and in the show organization

When the candidate presents himself for the preliminary test to become a Student Judge for his first category the following requirements must be met:

- The candidate must have bred at least 3 litters under his own cattery name for a period of at least 3 years.
- The candidate must have experience as an exhibitor, i.e. he must have exhibited cats at a minimum number of 20 national or international shows. At least one cat registered under his own cattery name must have obtained the title GIC/GIP during the last 5 years.
- Experience in organizing shows is compulsory. Relevant experience includes positions such as show manager, experience in the secretariat or prize room etc.
- Experience as chief steward and/or ring secretary for various Judges is highly recommended.

Conforme estabelece, o artigo 2.1.5, o exame inicial será realizado por escrito na língua inglesa através de 40 questões definidas pela Judge & Standard Commission e conduzido pelo Membro FIFe à qual o candidato pertence, isto é, a FFB - Federação Felina Brasileira, através do "Student Judge Admission Form", onde serão informados:

- A categoria do aluno juiz
- A data, local e país onde o candidato ficará para exame
- Os nomes dos Fiscais:

A FFB indicará dentro do possível, os fiscais, como sendo:

- a. Um membro da diretoria
- b. Um juiz FIFe

Obs: No processo de Admissão ao Aluno Juiz, os fiscais não necessitam ser Juízes.

2.1.5 Preliminary examination, admission as Student Judge

Once the candidate has completed the required 10 or 20 steward assignments, he must sit a written preliminary examination set by the Judges and Standards Commission.

This examination must be taken in the English language and will be conducted by the Member to which the candidate belongs.

The examination shall consist of 40 questions of those at least 25 from the general part of the questionnaires. The examination is to be completed within a maximum period of 120 minutes.

A minimum of 80% of the possible marks must be achieved in order to gain a pass; less than this means the candidate has failed.

The Member must send the original relevant steward certificates with the application to the FIFe General Secretary no later than when requesting the preliminary exam for the candidate.

For this purpose, the FIFe has issued a special form: this standard application for admission of a Student Judge is the only valid application form.

The application should include:

- the choice of Category (e.g. Category 1, 2, 3 or 4),
- the date, place and country where the candidate intends to sit for the examination,
- the names of the invigilators.

The FIFe General Secretary must receive this application at least two months prior to the date of the examination.

The Member must send the original copy of the examination together with the marks achieved to the FIFe General Secretary, no later than one month after the examination. The FIFe General Secretary will check the documentation before sending the Member the official notification of admitting the candidate as a FIFe Student Judge.

O Aluno Juiz deve ser capaz de se comunicar na língua oficial de Juiz instrutor e em pelo menos uma das três línguas oficiais da FIFe (inglês, francês ou alemão)

2.1.6 Requirements for Student Judges concerning the Instructing Judges

The Student Judge must be able to speak the official FIFe language of the Instructing Judge. The Student Judge must be able to communicate fluently in that language.

Generally, a Student Judge must be able to communicate fluently in at least one of the three official languages of FIFe. Student Judges, who have one of the official FIFe languages for their native language, should at least be able to speak and write in one of the other official FIFe languages.

It is highly recommended that the Student Judge sits with as many different Instructing Judges as possible.

È mandatório que os alunos juízes em sua primeira categoria sejam guiados por um Juiz Mentor, sendo preferível que o aluno juiz selecione um Juiz Mentor de seu próprio país.

2.1.7 Mentorship for Student Judges

It is mandatory for Students who are taking their first category to be under the guidance of a Mentor Judge.

It is preferred that a Student selects a Mentor Judge from his own country.

As a minimum, the Student must be able to communicate fluently both verbally and in writing with the Mentor Judge.
